- Practical information on the process of measuring up areas for the design and installation of internal and external ramps
- Information about resources to assist with measuring and designing ramps
- Information about current literature and research influencing the prescription of grabrails
- Knowledge about the biomechanics and measurement techniques to inform clinical reasoning processes for grabrail prescription
- Information about resources to assist with prescribing grabrails and handrails
